Sunday, 6/18 - SINGLES TOURNAMENT FORMAT – QUALIFYING

DAY 2 of 3 – Boys "Singles" Division & Girls "Singles" Division

(Below are estimated times for each Survivor Round)

Boys Qualifying (from Teams) 9 a.m. / Girls Teams and Singles & Boys Singles-only 2 p.m.

- **QUALIFYING ROUND:** All bowlers play 4 games of regular bowling. The Top 140 boys and Top 100 girls with the highest FOUR-game total pinfall will advance to Survivor Round 1 on Monday at 9 a.m.
Total pinfall for each bowler will carry over into Monday's Survivor Round 1 at 9 a.m.

Monday, 6/19 - SINGLES TOURNAMENT FORMAT – SURVIVOR MATCHPLAY

DAY 3 of 3 – Boys "Singles" Division & Girls "Singles" Division

- **9 a.m. SURVIVOR ROUND 1:** All of the top-140 boys and top-100 girls will play 2 additional games of regular bowling. The top-60 boys and top-40 girls with the highest SIX games of total pinfall in each division will advance to Survivor Round 2. Total pinfall for each bowler will carry over into the next round.
- **10:45 a.m. SURVIVOR ROUND 2:** All of the top-60 boys and top-40 girls will play 1 additional game of regular bowling. The top-20 boys and the top-16 girls with the highest SEVEN games of total pinfall in each division will advance to Survivor Round 3. Total pinfall for each bowler will carry over into the next round.
- **12 p.m. SURVIVOR ROUND 3:** All of the top-20 boys and top-16 girls will play 1 additional game of regular bowling. The top-8 boys and top-8 girls bowlers with the highest EIGHT games of total pinfall in each division will advance to Survivor Round 4. Total pinfall for each bowler will carry over into the next round.
- **1 p.m. "ELITE EIGHT" SURVIVOR ROUND 4:** All of the top-8 boys and top-8 girls will play 1 game of regular bowling. The top 4 bowlers with the highest NINE games of total pinfall in each division will advance to "Final Four" Survivor Round 5. **HOWEVER, the bowler with the highest total pinfall AFTER the Elite Eight Survivor Round 4 (9 total games) will be automatically seeded into the Championship Survivor Match and will receive a bye in the "Final Four" Survivor Round 5!** ALL PINFALL IS DROPPED FOR THE 'FINAL FOUR' ROUND 5.
- **2 p.m. "FINAL FOUR" SURVIVOR ROUND 5:** The 2nd, 3rd, and 4th highest total pinfall in each division will play 1 game of regular bowling. The highest single-game score of the three bowlers in each division from the "Final Four" Survivor Round 5 will advance to the "Championship" Survivor Round 7. ALL PINFALL IS DROPPED FOR THE 'CHAMPIONSHIP' ROUND 6.
- **3 p.m. "CHAMPIONSHIP" SURVIVOR ROUND 6:** All bowlers play 1 game of regular bowling. The highest game in each division will be declared the winner of their respective divisions. The individual boy and girl winners will be the 2023 Boys "Singles" U.S. High School Bowling National Champion and 2023 Girls "Singles" U.S. High School Bowling National Champion.

Both "Singles" National Champions will earn National Championship "Singles" RINGS!
